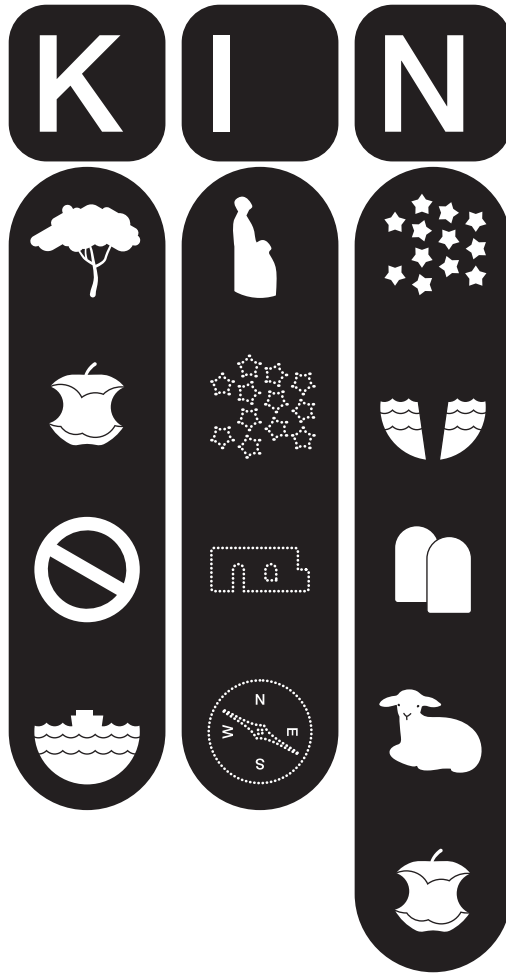

Yahweh Graciously Redeems His People

◆ 2:23–25; 6:2–8

◆ 3:14–15

◆ 3:19–20; 4:1–5, 22–23

❖ Slaying the serpent in the sea (Isa 51:9–11; Job 26:12–13)

❖ A second exodus (Jer 23:3–8; Hos 3:5; 11:10–11; Zech 10:10–11; Luke 9:30–31)

Yahweh Graciously Relates to His People

◆ 19:4–6

Exegetical Outline of Exod 19:4–6

- ◆ **The basis of God’s calling for his people:** God’s deliverance (v. 4)
- ◆ **The nature of God’s calling for his people:** to exalt God in the world
 - ❖ *The means* for fulfilling the calling to exalt God in the world (v. 5)
 - ❖ Heed God’s voice
 - ❖ Keep God’s covenant
 - ❖ Exist as God’s treasured possession in the context of the world
 - ❖ *The essence* of the calling to exalt God in the world (v. 6)
 - ❖ Serve as a kingdom of priests: mediate God’s greatness and worth
 - ❖ Serve as a holy nation: display God’s greatness and worth

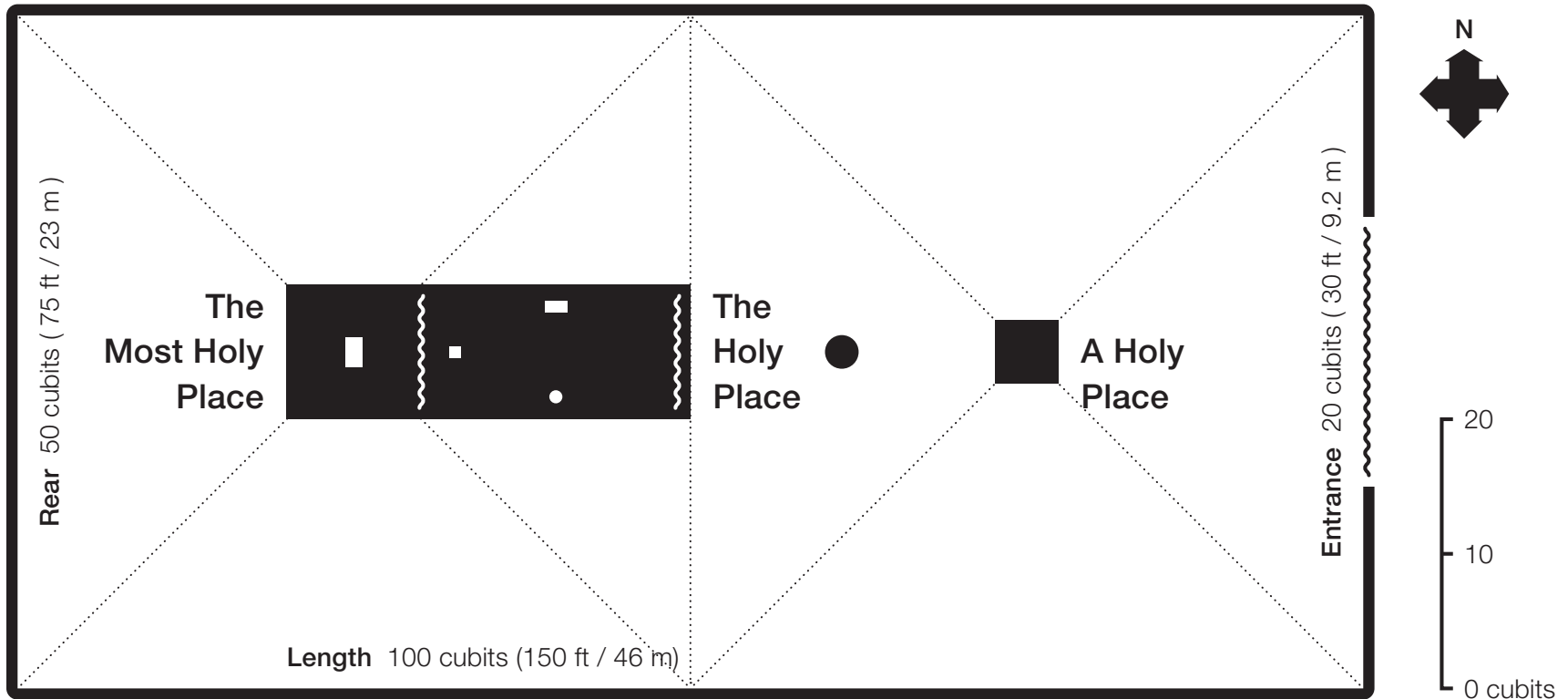

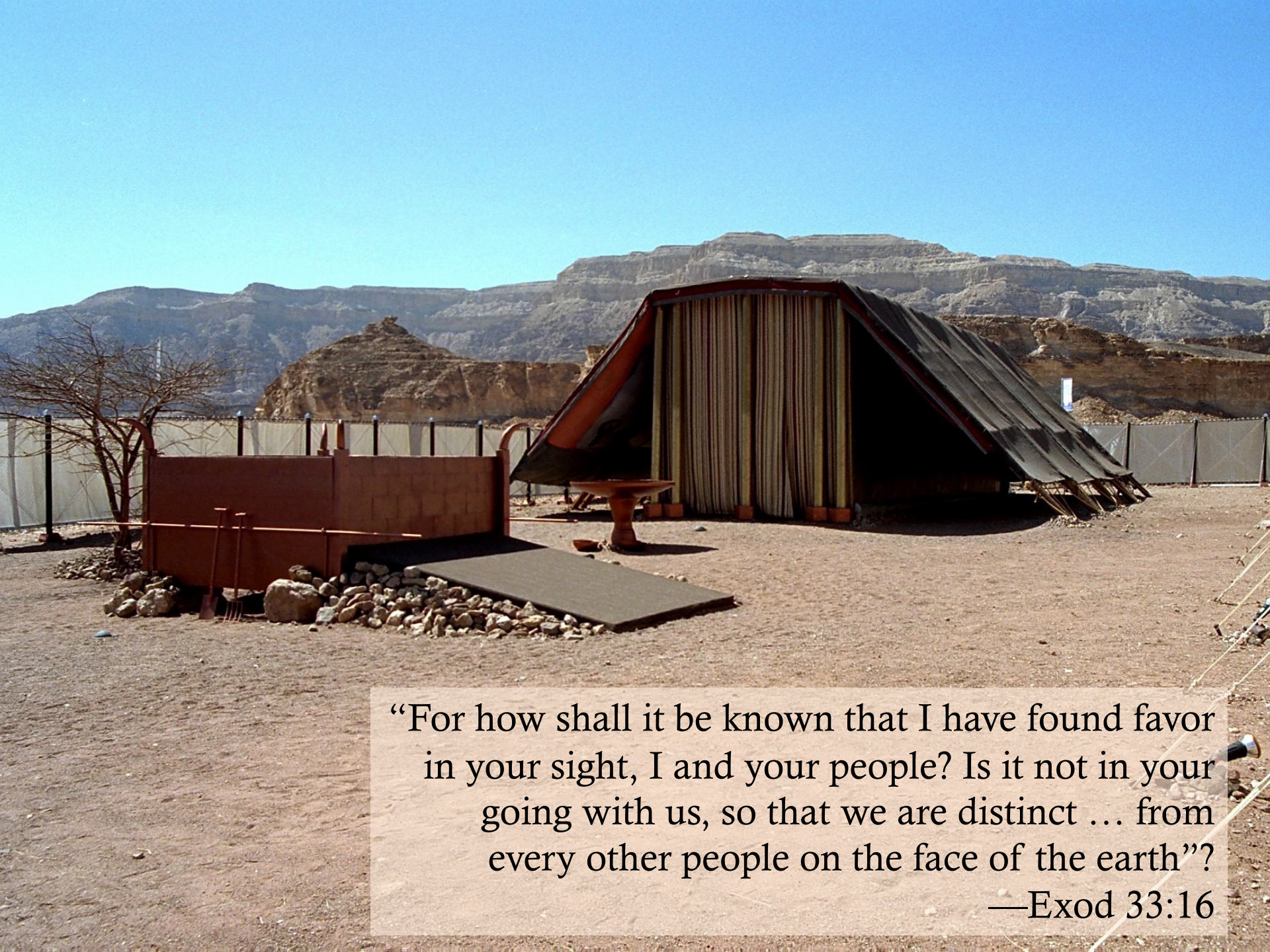
