



♦ The Significance of Numbers in Numbers

- Census numbers:
 - Num 1: 603,550 + 22,000 Levites = 625,550
 - Num 26: 601,730 + 23,000 Levites = 624,730
- **!** Lessons:
 - God takes sin seriously.
 - God does what he promises, whether to bless or to curse.
